2 PURPOSE

This is the Qualifying Series for members of the International Etchells Sydney Fleet Inc. who wish to compete in the 2010 World Etchells Championship to be held in San Diego, USA 6-15 June 2011.

- 3.1 Helmspersons and co-helmspersons shall comply with the requirement of Rule 6 - ENTRY - DEFINITIONS AND ELIGIBILITY of the "Rules Governing the World Championship and other Sanctioned Events" as outlined on the International Etchells Class web site at www.etchells.org.au/.
- 3.8 There shall be a maximum combined crew weight of 285kg in accordance with the rules of the International Etchells Class Association.
- 6.2 A boat shall drop three series pointscore races for her final points in the Qualifying Series. Thirteen of the sixteen races shall count. In the event of 13 or less races being completed, all shall count.

2 PURPOSE

- 3.1 Helmspersons and co-helmspersons shall comply with the requirement of Rule 6 - ENTRY - DEFINITIONS AND ELIGIBILITY of the "Rules Governing the World Championship and other Sanctioned Events" as outlined on the International Etchells Class web site at www.etchells.org/.
- 3.8 There shall be a maximum combined crew weight of 285kg in accordance with the rules of the International Etchells Class Association. Two crew Weigh-ins are mandatory. Times for weigh-ins are as follows:
First weigh-in: Friday 10th September 5.00 – 6.30pm or Saturday 11th September 8.30am -10.00am in the Youth Training Room at RSYS.
Second weigh-in: Friday 19th November 5.00pm to 6.30pm or Saturday 20th November from 8.30am – 10.00am in the Youth Training Room at RSYS.
Crews that fail to re-weigh by the designated times or fail to make the weight limit shall be scored DNS for all races sailed that day and for all subsequent races until such time as they comply with One-Design Rule 7.1. The Race Committee may approve an extension of time in extenuating circumstances, and such requests shall be submitted in writing to the Race Committee.
- 6.2 All races shall count.
