Australian basic quota positions to the 2011 International Yngling World Championships in Austria and the 2012 International Yngling World Championships in Australia will be allocated using the following selection criteria.

The Selection series shall be comprised of the following 5 events,

- 2010 International Yngling NSW State Championships – 6-7 November 2010
- 2010 International Yngling Australian Championships – 27-29 December 2010
- 2010/11 King Haakon Cup – 11 December 2010 & 29 January 2011
- 2011 Audi Regatta – 5-6 March 2011
- 2011 Autumn Regatta – 2 April 2011

Teams shall count their best scores in the following divisions

1. Australian Championship
2. State Championship
3. 2 Events not counted in divisions 1 or 2

The final results of these regattas shall be scored according to the following formula.

$$R=P*Q*E$$

Ranking Points

R = the ranking points from the regatta

Placement points

P= 101 – The boat's position in the regatta
e.g. 100 for 1st, 99 for 2nd, 98 for 3rd and so on

Quality Index

Q= $1+n/30$ where n is the number of boats in the event
Q= 1.5 for Australian Championships

Event Index

E= 1 for the Division 3 events
2 for the State Championships
3 for Australian Championships

Boats shall be selected from the highest scoring boat down to fill all the available positions offered by the International Yngling Association.

Boats changing crews or helms during the selection series shall notify the Selection Committee. The selection committee will then rule as to whether the crew or helm change will result in the crew being classified as a new boat for the purposes of the selection series.
