FACTS FOUND

1. Division 3's course No 1 was signalled by the Race Committee.
2. Boats rounded the Obelisk Bay Mark and proceeded towards the Steel Point Mark.
3. The Steel Point Mark was located north of Shark Island as described in the Sailing Instructions, but further north than its usual position.
4. All boats rounded the Steel Point Mark correctly.

CONCLUSION

No boats score in the race was made significantly worse.
