Top up selection for 2012 World Championships

Additional Australian positions to the 2012 World Championships as allocated by the IYA will be decided using the following selection criteria.

The Selection series shall be comprised of the following 3 events,

- 17th September 2011 - Mini Regatta at on Sydney Harbour
- 15th October 2011 - Mini Regatta at on Sydney Harbour
- 5-6th November 2011 – Yngling Australian Championship on Sydney Harbour

The final results of these regattas shall be scored according to the following formula.

$$\mathbf{R=P*Q*E}$$

Ranking Points

R = the ranking points from the regatta

Placement points

P= 101 – The boat's position in the regatta
e.g. 100 for 1st, 99 for 2nd, 98 for 3rd and so on

Quality Index

Q= $1+n/30$ where n is the number of boats in the event

Event Index

E= 1 for the Mini-regattas
2 for the Australian Championships

Boats shall be scored from their two highest scoring events.

Boats shall be selected from the highest scoring boat down to fill all the available positions offered by the International Yngling Association.

Boats changing crews or helms during the selection series shall notify the Selection Committee. The selection committee will then rule as to whether the crew or helm change will result in the crew being classified as a new boat for the purposes of the selection series.

Selection is based on the Skipper of the team

Wild cards will be allocated to the first Youth Team in the 2010 Gold Cup and the first Ladies Team overall in the 2010-11 Tuesday night twilight series. Should those skippers have already qualified, then the Wild Cards may be offered to the next placed skippers.

Any additional wild cards will be allocated at the discretion of the AIYA Executive.
