2. A signed SASC CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FORM (Overleaf)

Note: INSURANCE TO BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SASC GENERAL SAILING INSTRUCTION RULE 33 (OWNERS MAY BE REQUIRED TO PRODUCE EVIDENCE OF SUCH INSURANCE)

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Sydney Amateur Sailing Club - Conditions of Entry

1. The owner, charterer or representative acknowledges the possibility of and accepts the risk associated with:
 - (a) the perils of the sea;
 - (b) the seaworthiness or otherwise of any other boat participating in any race comprising part of the Sydney Amateur Sailing Club (SASC) races;
 - (c) the participation, including negligent participation, by all persons in any such race. Including participation as owner, charterer, crew person, official, race organiser or otherwise;
 - (d) the defaults, acts and omissions, including negligent defaults, acts and omissions, of Sydney Amateur Sailing Club and its officers and officials, and the crews of all boats.

2. The owner, charterer or representative acknowledges and accepts that the Sydney Amateur Sailing Club:
 - (a) does not or cannot control, diminish or affect the perils of the sea;
 - (b) does not certify the seaworthiness or suitability to race of any boat;
 - (c) is not in a position to provide advice, assistance or support to boats and crews during the course of any such race.

3. The owner, charterer or representative agrees that:
 - (a) it is a fundamental condition of entry that he, she or it releases, holds harmless and indemnifies the Sydney Amateur Sailing Club, its officers, employees, agents and volunteers and/or any others involved in the sponsorship of such races from all liability any of those persons has to the owner or charterer or any crew member on the boat, or to any person claiming through or under any such person, arising from loss or damage howsoever caused, including by negligent act or omission, arising out of or relating to:
 - (i) participation by the owner's, charterer's or representative's boat or any other boat in the Sydney Amateur Club race;
 - (ii) the conduct or course of the race in any respect including any act or omission (whether reasonably foreseeable or not) causing or relating to loss of or damage to any boat or the death or injury to any person; or
 - (iii) any of the matters referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2;
 - (b) participation by the boat and crew in any race comprising part of a Sydney Amateur Sailing Club race is agreed by Sydney Amateur Sailing Club on the basis that participation is entirely at the risk of the owner, charterer or representative and each member of the crew on the boat.

4. The owner, charterer or representative agrees that if, during the course of any Sydney Amateur Sailing Club race, the owner, charterer, representative or any person authorised on the owner's or charterer's behalf requests any officer, employee or volunteer of the Sydney Amateur Sailing Club to arrange for special assistance because the boat has become disabled, or for any other reason, then the owner, charterer or representative indemnifies Sydney Amateur Sailing Club and its officers, employees, volunteers and agents in respect of any liability, cost or expense which may thereby be incurred.

I have read and agree to be bound by these **Conditions of Entry** and by the Racing Rules of the ISAF (RRS), by the prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia, the General Sailing Instructions of the Sydney Amateur Sailing Club and the Sailing Instructions as they apply to each race.
