Please indicate the number of tickets you require for each of these functions. ***Please place your orders carefully - once the cruise begins we cannot guarantee that numbers will be able to be changed.***

- **YA Special Regulation Forms** are required for all boats competing in the racing;
  - Inshore races only: Category 7 or higher
  - Offshore races: Category 4 or higher (Cat 7 only required for Race 5)

If you have not forwarded this form already please do so at your earliest convenience.

- **Compulsory Briefing:** all competitors are required to be represented at this briefing to be held on Wednesday 16 April 1900 hours in the Kirribilli Room. Important information about weather and safety issues will be discussed. If your boat is not represented at this briefing we cannot guarantee your participation in the Cruise.
