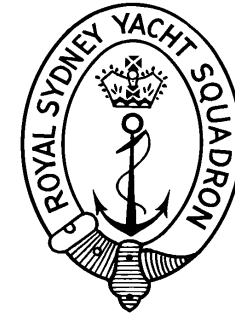
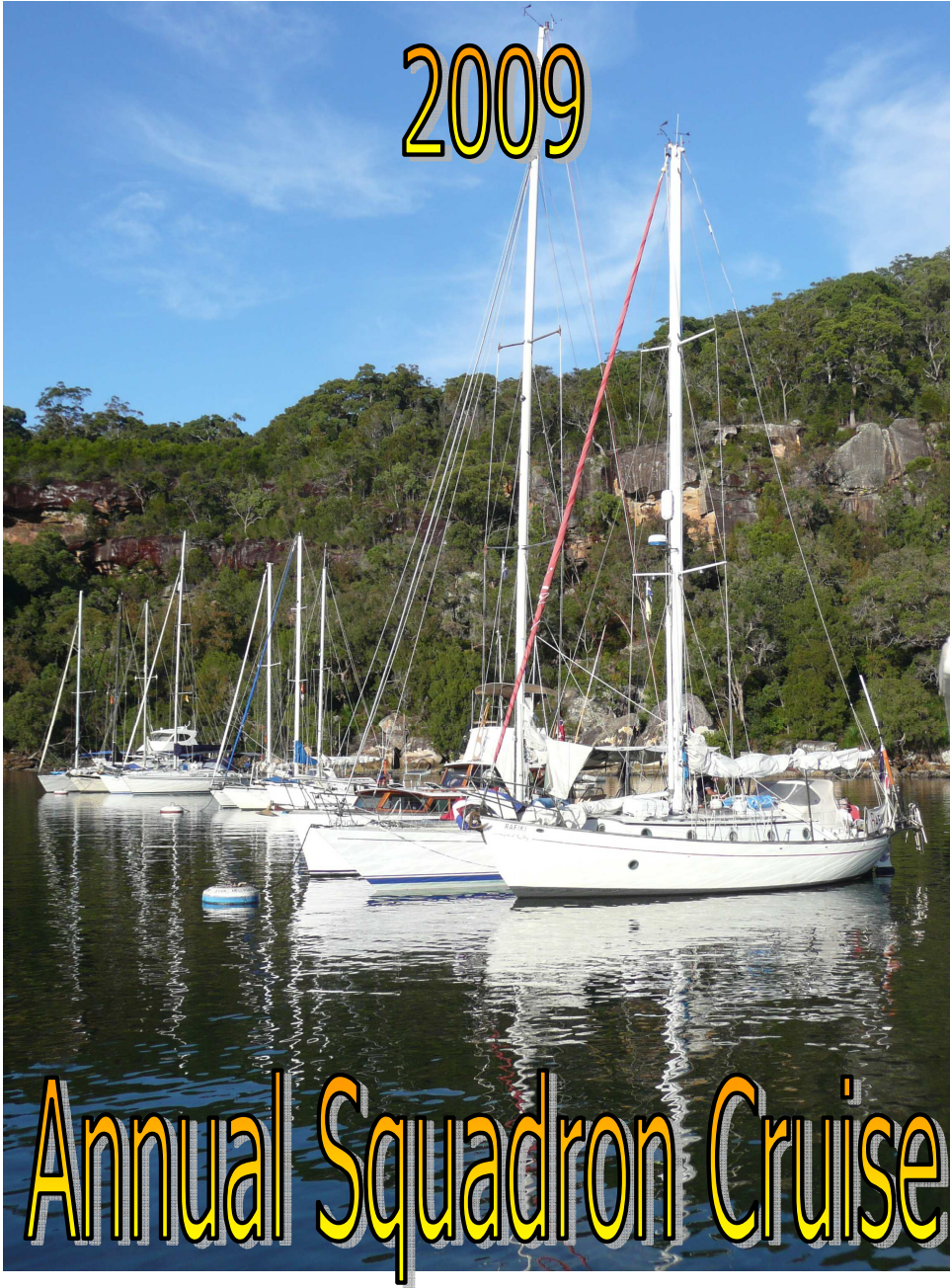

TENDER SERVICE

Tender service will be limited for this year's cruise. Participants are encouraged to bring their own dinghy's & RIB's if possible.

CRUISE & DIVISION FLAGS

You are reminded that as per the Sailing Instructions, "all participating yachts, competing and cruising, are required to fly the Squadron Cruise Flag and if racing, their Division Flag continuously from their backstays from first joining until leaving the Cruise."

According to your division the following flag will be required:

Non Spinnaker Div 1	Flag 'U'
Non Spinnaker Div 2	Flag 'F'
Non Spinnaker Div 3	Flag 'T'

A Provisional List of Entries will be available the week prior to the Cruise.

Flags (Cruise & Division) can be purchased from the Sailing Office for \$35.00 each.

Time to farewell old and new friends back at the Squaddy. Grab a table in the Careening Cove for a final 'de-brief' session prior to returning home to reality

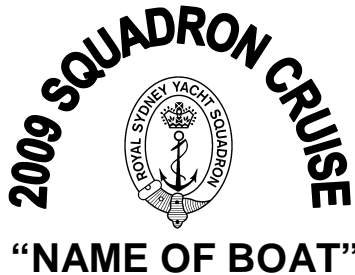
