Participants are encouraged to bring their own dinghys & RIBs if possible.

CRUISE & DIVISION FLAGS

All yachts, competing and cruising, are required to fly the Squadron Cruise flag and if racing, their division flag, continuously from their backstays from first joining until leaving the Cruise.

According to your division the following flag will be required.

Non Spinnaker Div 1	Flag 'U'
Non Spinnaker Div 2	Flag 'T'
Non Spinnaker Div 3	Flag 'F'

A Provisional List of Entries will be available the week prior to the Cruise.

EVENT 7: SATURDAY 17 APRIL INFORMAL FAREWELL AT THE SQUADRON

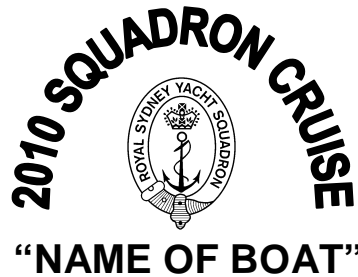
Time to farewell old and new friends back at the Squaddy. Grab a table in the Careening Cove Anchorage for a final 'de-brief' session prior to returning home to reality
