Facts Found:

- 1. The course signalled by the Race Committee for Division 2 to be sailed on Saturday 23 September 2023 was Easterly course No.2.
- 2. The sailing instructions states: Easterly course No.2 the marks are to be rounded in the following order: RM(P) *KP(P) RM(P) KP(P) Finish: vicinity of Woollahra Point. Approximately 10.0 nm.
- 3. The sailing instructions describe the mark RM as an orange inflatable buoy marked with the letters "RSYS" and will be located approximately 550 metres south of Shark Island.
- 4. The Race Committee did not lay the correct orange RM mark.
- 5. The Race Committee laid a yellow mark without club identification.
- 6. No protest flag is required.
- 7. No boat sailed the course signalled by the Race Committee.
- 8. Arcturus 3 lodged a request for redress.
- 9. All entrants in the event were notified by the RSYS Sailing Office of the time and place of the request for redress hearing and were invited to attend.
- 10. Solange was the only other boat to be represented at the hearing.

Rules Applicable:

RRS 28.1, 32.1, 62.1(a) & 62.2

Conclusions:

- 1. The laying of a mark in Rose Bay that did not comply with the description specified by the sailing instructions was an improper act or omission on the part of the Race Committee.
- 2. Arcturus 3 is entitled to redress.

Decision:

Race 3 is to be abandoned.
