



## CLUB ACCESS FOR NON-MEMBER PARENTS & GUARDIANS

#### Parking and Vehicular Access

- Spray Jacket / Wind Jacket
- Sailing Gloves
- Towel
- Gear Bag with zipper
- Dry change of clothes
- Water bottle / Lunch /Snack
- RSYS Red Bib is mandatory at supported regattas. Bibs can be purchased from the Academy Office during weekdays at a cost of \$45

- A participant shall own their own fibreglass Optimist.

#### OPTIMIST INTERMEDIATE AND OPEN SQUAD

- A participant shall be a financial Youth Member or hold a current RSYS Sail Pass.
- A participant shall demonstrate a high level of skill in Optimist.
- A participant shall have a strong interest in racing.
- A participant shall own their own fibreglass Optimist.

#### LASER DEVELOPMENT SQUAD

- A participant shall be a financial Youth Member/Intermediate Member, Full Metropolitan Member or hold a current RSYS Sail Pass.
- Boat ownership is encouraged.

#### LASER ADVANCED SQUAD

- A participant shall be a financial Youth Member/Intermediate Member, Full Metropolitan Member or hold a current RSYS Sail Pass.
- A participant shall own their own Laser.

#### PACER SQUAD

- A participant shall be a financial RSYS Youth Member or hold a current RSYS Sail Pass.
- A participant shall demonstrate a high level of skill in Dinghies.
- A participant shall have a strong interest in racing.
- Submit a summary of prior sailing experience to be reviewed by the Lead Coach.

# CANCELLATION & REFUNDS POLICY

The below policy outlines the terms and conditions related to refunds and cancellations for our Youth Sailing Program. Please read this policy carefully BEFORE enrolling your child in the Squadron Dinghy Program.

- 1. **Commitment** When enrolling in the Summer Squadron Dinghy Program, participants are committing to the Full Season. This commitment enables us to plan and ensure a consistent and cohesive training experience for all involved.
- 2. No Partial Refunds We do not offer refunds, either in full or in part, for cancellations or missed sessions once the season has commenced. This policy applies to all reasons for missing a session including Illness, personal commitments, or other unforeseen circumstances.
- 3. Cancellation before a season commences If a participant wishes to cancel their enrolment before the start of the season, they must notify us in writing no later than seven days prior to the season's commencement date. In such cases, a full refund will be provided minus any administrative fees.
- 4. **Exceptions** Any exceptions to this policy may be considered on a case-by-case basis in extraordinary circumstances. Such exceptions are at the sole discretion of the Academy Committee.
- 5. **Enquires** If you have any questions or need further clarification regarding this policy, please contact our Academy Administrator.
- 6. Agreement By enrolling your child in the Summer Squadron Dinghy Program, you acknowledge and agree to comply with this Refund and Cancellation Policy.

# BOAT REQUIREMENTS

**RSYS** Sailing

- Lasers shall comply with the current International <u>ILCA Class Rules</u>.
- Optimist shall comply with the current International <u>Optimist Class Rules</u>.
- A boat shall comply with the current Special Regulations (Part 2) of Australian Sailing Ltd, Off The Beach Equipment Audit Form. <u>https://cdn.revolutionise.com.au/site/ffibezh5drjdgta5.pdf</u>
- A boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance, with a minimum cover of not less than AUD \$5,000,000 (recommended AUD \$10,000,000).
- Club Lasers are available for Development Squad participants to hire at a cost of \$50 per day. Priority will be given to new squad participants. If you would like to charter a laser please contact the Academy Administrator.
- RSYS Pacers are available to the Pacer Squad, hire is included with the program fees.

# **BUYING AND SELLING DINGHIES**

If you are looking to buy or sell an Optimist or Laser, we recommend you check Buy-Sell pages on Facebook, Gumtree and the notice board in the RSYS carpark.

# RACKING

RSYS can provide on-site boat storage for sailor's Optimist and Lasers in the dinghy racking located on the southern side of the underground carpark, however, due to limited capacity racking spaces are not guaranteed and priority is given in accordance with the following criteria.

- Parent/Guardian/Grandparent/Intermediate/Metropolitan RSYS Membership.
- Frequency of use and participation in the RSYS Dinghy Program.
- Training frequency in preparation for upcoming events.

If you require a racking space, please contact Vanessa, our Academy Administrator.

Dinghies stored at RSYS are NOT covered by the Club's insurance policy. For the benefit of boat owners and other sailors, RSYS requires all privately owned boats should carry \$5,000,000 third party liability insurance as a minimum.

# CLUB DINGHY RACE SERIES

Race entry fees are included in each term fee. Sailors will need to complete an entry in the Club's race management system SailSys. It is critical that the sail number that is on your sail matches the sail number on your boat's profile when you enter for the race series.

RSYS Members are welcome to join the Club Racing Series. Winter Season Club Racing consists of 7 Race Days for \$250 members fee and \$375 for non-members for the season and is payable via Revolutionise Sport<u>Register Here</u>

# SQUADRON OPTIMIST PROGRAM (SOP)

# GREEN FLEET SQUAD

The SOP Green Fleet Squad is targeted at sailors aged 8-15 years old, who have recently completed the Sunday Tackers program and are looking for a fun introduction to racing. Sailors are expected to have a good grasp of the fundamentals of sailing, competent boat handling skills, ability to rig their own dinghy and an understanding of the basic racing rules.

On-water sessions will focus on developing an intermediate standard of boat handling skills in the Optimist and develop an understanding of race strategy.

(SOP) GREEN FLEET SESSION TIMES Sunday On-Water Session : Start Time 0830 - End Time 1200

Start Time is at briefing start time, therefore sailors must be dressed ready to sail and have their dinghy rigged prior to start time. End Time is when debriefs conclude. If sailors are not changed, derigged, and packed up before debriefing, they will need to do so after end time, under parental supervision.

#### REGATTAS

At Optimist regattas, Green Fleet coaching is usually provided by the host club. Green Fleet sailors are welcome to join the Optimist Performance Squad for briefings at supported regattas.



# SQUADRON OPTIMIST PROGRAM (SOP) INTERMEDIATE AND OPEN SQUAD

The SOP Intermediate/Open Squad is targeted at sailors who have demonstrated an intermediatehigh level of skill in the Optimist and are participating in local class regattas. Sailors are expected to have a deeper understanding of racing principles and strong boat handling skills.

For sailors wishing to strengthen their skills and compete in State and National regattas we recommend committing to the two-day program as stated below.

(SOP) INTERMEDIATE AND OPEN SQUAD TWO DAY PROGRAM Sunday On-Water Session : Start Time 0830 - End Time 1200 Tuesday On-Water Session : Start Time 0600 - End Time 0800

(SOP) INTERMEDIATE AND OPEN SQUAD - SUNDAY ONLY PROGRAM Sunday On-Water Session : Start Time 0830 - End Time 1200

Start Time is at briefing start time, therefore sailors must be dressed ready to sail and have their dinghy rigged prior to start time. End Time is when debriefs conclude. If sailors are not changed, derigged, and packed up before debriefing, they will need to do so after end time, under parental supervision.

#### SUPPORTED REGATTAS

Support at the following regatta will be offered for the Winter Season at an additional fee and is not included in the Winter Dinghy Squad fees.

We strongly encourage our Intermediate & Open sailors to attend these regatta, as competitions are vital in gaining experience in larger races.

# All session times will require a minimum number of participants at the start of the season to go ahead.

Fee Criteria:

- Youth sailors (U/18) with a parent/grandparent/guardian who is a RSYS Member are eligible to receive the Member's price.
- Youth sailors (U/18) without a parent/grandparent/guardian RSYS Member and who are participating in an RSYS Dinghy Program are only eligible for the non-member fee.

The SOP fees are inclusive of all Training Sessions, Sunday sausage sizzle and RSYS Club Racing. Additional cost associated with Membership, Boat Hire and/or Storage, RSYS Training Camps, Regattas, Annual Squad Summer Camp and End of Season Presentations may be incurred.

# SQUADRON LASER PROGRAM (SLP) DEVELOPMENT SQUAD

The SLP Development Squad is targeted at those who may have aged out of Optimist or had experience in other Dinghy classes and are aiming to gain skills in this single-handed class. Here sailors will develop Laser (ILCA) specific racing skills and work on progressing over time to the SLP Advanced Squad.

#### (SLP) LASER DEVELOPMENT SQUAD PROGRAM - SUNDAY ONLY Sunday On-Water Session Start Time 0830 - End Time 1200

Start Time is at briefing start time, therefore sailors must be dressed ready to sail and have their dinghy rigged prior to start time. End Time is when debriefs conclude. If sailors are not changed, derigged, and packed up before debriefing, they will need to do so after end time.

# SQUADRON LASER PROGRAM (SLP) ADVANCED SQUAD

The SLP Advanced Squad is open to our Laser development sailors who have been selected to progress by the SLP Senior Coach or for sailors from other clubs with proven Laser sailing experience.

The goal of the squad is to develop sailors into athletes competing at state, national and international level. Therefore, sailors are expected to attend the local ILCA circuit and *spend time developing their skills outside training sessions*.

For sailors wishing to strengthen their skills and compete in State and National regattas we recommend committing to the two-day program as stated below.

(SLP) LASER ADVANCED SQUAD - TWO DAY PROGRAMSunday On-Water Session :Start Time 0830 - End Time 1200Tuesday On-Water Session :Start Time 0600 - End Time 0800

Start Time is at briefing start time; therefore, sailors must be dressed ready to sail and have their dinghy rigged prior to start time. End Time is when debriefs conclude. If sailors are not changed, derigged, and packed up before debriefing, they will need to do so after end time.



#### SUPPORTED REGATTAS

We recommend our Advanced Squad sailors attend the regattas mentioned below, as competitions are vital in gaining the experience necessary to qualify for state, national and world teams.

Sailors wishing to improve their regatta ranking are encouraged to attend as many supported and unsupported regattas as possible. Additionally, attending race days held by other clubs within the local area and spending time on the water developing skills outside of the RSYS training sessions is strongly encouraged.

# SQUADRON PACER PROGRAM (SPP) SQUAD

The SPP Squad is targeted at sailors who have some prior sailing experience and are looking to further develop their skills in a two-handed dinghy. They may have completed a learn to sail course and want to start regularly sailing or be an active dinghy racer looking for your new challenge. Sailors are expected to have an understanding of the fundamentals of sailing and basic racing rules.

The Pacer Squad will train once a week and focus on developing an intermediate to advanced standard of boat handling skills, develop their teamwork skills and be introduced to both fleet and team racings strategy and tactics.

#### PACER SQUAD - SUNDAY ONLY PROGRAM

Sunday On-Water Session : Start Time : 0830 - End Time 1200

Start Time is at briefing start time therefore sailors must be dressed ready to sail and have their dinghy rigged prior to start time. End Time is when debriefs conclude. If sailors are not changed, derigged, and packed up before debriefing, they will need to do so after end time, under parental supervision.
