Please be advised that the Careening Cove Anchorage (CCA) will be closed from Monday 29 June and will reopen on Saturday 1 August.

During this period, the CCA bar area and outdoor space will remain open daily from 7.30am to 3.00pm. A limited offering will be available, including:

- Continental breakfast (pastries, muffins, yoghurt; no cooked items)
- Light lunch (fresh and toasted sandwiches and hot chips only)

The Dining Room will operate for lunch Monday through Sunday and for dinner Tuesday through Saturday. We are closed on Sunday and Monday evenings. Our lunch menu mirrors the dinner offering, with additional lower-priced options available.

Safe Boating Information

All boats must comply with all NSW Waterways regulations. These will be addressed at the skippers brief. All boats shall not interfere with the Commercial or Defence shipping of the Port. The attention of skippers is drawn to NSW Maritime Authority regulations regarding the right of way of vessels entering or leaving port, and vessels engaged in towing. NSW Maritime regulations specify **“priority over sail”**, some commercial ferries on Sydney Harbour display an orange diamond shape which grants priority of way over sailing vessels. **Do not attempt to cross the path of an approaching ferry displaying this signal.**

Dress Regulations

Careening Cove Anchorage – smart casual

Jeans and sneakers are not permitted in the Carabella dining room.

Mobile Phones

Please be aware that the **use of mobile phones is prohibited** in the Squadron clubhouse. The sending or receiving of email, text messages or accessing data is permitted.

Change Rooms and Showers

Both the men's and women's change room facilities are located downstairs, just above the Boatshed Office. These facilities have hot showers, toilets, lockers and a changing area. Individuals are urged to use the lockers in the change rooms for the storage of any personal items. Please be advised that you need to provide your own padlock and key.

Toilets

The men's toilets are located near the rear entrance to the clubhouse, near the Members Bar. Alternatively, there are toilets in the change room, which are located downstairs above the Boatshed Office.

The women's toilets are located behind the Neutral Bay Room in the clubhouse. Alternatively, there are toilets in the change room, which are located downstairs above the Boatshed Office.

Valuables

Competitors are discouraged from bringing valuables to the Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron. If necessary, teams are asked to use the lockers located in the change rooms. The RSY will not assume any responsibility for the loss, theft or damage of personal possessions.

Lost Property

Lost property cupboards are located under the washbasins in the male and female change rooms. All lost property will be tagged with the date it is found and if unclaimed within one month, will be donated to charity. All valuable items will be held at Reception.

Smoking

All areas of the clubhouse are smoke-free zones. Staff will not provide ashtrays. Receptacles for extinguishing cigarette butts are located at all entrances to the clubhouse.

Alcohol Consumption

Staff will not sell or supply alcohol to a person who appears to be under the age of 18 years, nor allow that person to consume alcohol upon the RSY premises. Staff will not serve alcohol to any person who appears to be intoxicated or affected by drugs or alcohol. The RSY encourages the responsible consumption of alcohol in moderation. Intoxicated, indecent or aggressive persons will be escorted from the premises.

RSYS Bar Facilities

The Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron has two bar facilities within the clubhouse. The Members Bar is located adjacent to the Carabella Room and on the same level as Reception. The Careening Cove Anchorage (CCA) Bar is located downstairs from the Members Bar with the adjoining terrace to sit and enjoy a drink and the magnificent harbour view.

Car Parking

Club parking is reserved for RSY Members only.

A limited allocation of five (5) car parking spaces has been made available for competitors travelling from outside the Sydney metropolitan area.

Arriving at RSY with Road Trailers

Competitors arriving with a trailered vessel should enter the Club via the **upper Peel Street gate**, proceed to the designated hardstand unloading area, and unload their boat as directed. Once unloading is complete, vehicles should exit via the **upper Peel Street exit**.

Trailers: Trailers may be stored in the designated hardstand area for the duration of the regatta. Please follow all directions provided by Club Staff regarding trailer storage and vehicle movements within the Club grounds.
