START, FINISH AND MARK DESCRIPTIONS

- AB In the vicinity of Athol Bay
- BB AS mark 150m SW of Sow & Pigs Reef
- CBN The northern most AS mark in Chowder Bay, 200m SW of Georges Head
- CI Clarke Island
- CP AS mark 200m West of Cannae Point Flagstaff
- EC AS mark South of Sow & Pigs, 150m NW of Eastern Channel Pile
- LB AS mark 150m west of Lady Bay
- NP In the vicinity of Neilson Park
- PP In the vicinity of Point Piper
- RP In the vicinity of Robertson Point
- SIM AS mark SE of Shark Island (The area between the Shark Island AS Mark (SIM) and Shark Island is a continuing obstruction and no boat shall pass between them.)
- TB AS mark in Taylors Bay
- WM RSYs orange inflatable mark laid approx. to windward of the starting line.
