Race Documents

- The Squadron website has been updated with all the latest racing calendars and race documents.
- Any amendments to the race documents will be posted on the official notice board and sent directly to the relevant skippers.
- Any amendments can also be located on the squadron website under the Club Racing tab.
- The season program has been designed so that competitors can locate download or print, only the relevant sections required for the series or event in which they intend to race.



<u>Divisional Representatives</u>

Season Changes

- The name and description of the BB Buoy and now SP (Sow and Pigs) in accordance with the Australian Sailing guidelines.
 All course descriptions have been changed to reflect this.
- Revised courses for the mixed divisions on Saturdays,
 competitors should refer to the SIs for their new courses.
- Deletion of the WC mark for the Etchells and use of the SP mark in its place.
- Areas that are obstructions a) Other Starting and Finishing lines – the starting and finishing lines of another division of class or another club's race.



Season Changes

- We will no longer be issuing SIs for our three SOPS races; these are incorporated in the CYCA instructions. Entries are also through the CYCA.
- Morna Cup Saturday & Sunday 17 & 18 February. An opportunity to sail up to Pittwater and return.



Special Course

November 25 - Course 8 is scheduled for the mixed divisions.

Division 1 – variation of their Manly course

Division 2 – West Harbour course

Division 3 – North Harbour, Cannae Point course.



Courses

- Strongly suggest that everyone check the course description for the race they intend to race to ensure nothing has changed.
- Laminated course sheets and course descriptions are still available from the sailing office on request.



Combined Clubs Series

- Scheduled to be seven single race days throughout the season.
- These will be a separate series and will not be included in RSYS season point scores.
- Courses have been revised and will involve windward starts and finishes.
- Additional courses have been introduced to cater for most wind directions.



Combined Clubs Prizes for RSYS boats

- We will be awarding prizes back at club for RSYS boats in the combined clubs.
- Prizes for the highest placed RSYS boat in each race in each division.
- There will be a trophy for the overall highest placed RSYS boat in each division for the series.



Mini Regattas

- There are 13 Mini regattas scheduled for the season.
- There are some dates where not all classes will be involved due to other fleet commitments.
- Owners and skippers should check their individual calendar of events.
- The scheduled time of the first warning signal will be:
 - 1230hrs for the Yngling Mini Class
 - 1230hrs or 1330hrs during daylight saving for Etchells



Twilights

- The addition of a Thursday Twilight Series.
- Introduction of Prep flag "I" (around the ends). If you are over early, you have the opportunity to restart by rounding either the start pin or start boat, thereby exonerating yourself or risk being scored OCS.
- There is a more clearly defined obstruction area around the starting line which boats must keep clear of unless they are approaching the line to start.
- Boats not approaching the line to start must keep clear of boats that are approaching the line to start.



<u>SailGP</u>

- SailGP will be back on Sydney Harbour
 - Saturday & Sunday 24-25 February 2024.
- NSW Maritime have advised that SailGP exclusion zones will be active for the afternoon of Friday 23 February, practice day, however these restrictions should be lifted to enable the Friday twilight to go ahead usual.
