PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron's Keelboat Program was founded in 2000 and aims to provide Youth, Intermediate and Metropolitan Members with the opportunity to become involved with keelboat racing at a Club, national and international level. The Squadron Keelboat Program (SKP) is an advanced sail training program that will develop sailors' skills both on and off the water. The SKP will focus on all aspects of sailing, including racing rules, sail trim, boat maintenance, fitness, communication, and how to operate in a team environment. The 2023-2024 SKP program comprises Junior, Senior and Open programs. All SKP sailors will have the opportunity to test their skills throughout the season at various local and international match racing and fleet racing regattas. It is a requirement that all SKP participants are RSYS Members. Member participants under 18 must be part of an RSYS Family Membership or have a Member guardian/grandparent.

SKP FUTURE SAILORS

Active dinghy sailors, keelboat sailors, school sailing, RSYS keelboat camps and RSYS Youth/Intermediate Members

JUNIOR SQUAD (13 - 18YRS)

This squad is open to active sailors who can demonstrate a high level of fleet racing skills in either dinghies or keelboats.

Sailors will develop an intermediate to advanced level of keelboat handling skills and may apply to compete at local and state level fleet and match racing events.

SENIOR SQUAD (18 - 22YRS)

This squad is open to sailors who currently compete at a national level in dinghies or keelboats, or sailors who have previously participated in the SKP.

Sailors will refine their skills to an advanced level and may apply to compete at national and international events.

OPEN SQUAD (22YRS+)

This squad is open to sailors who can demonstrate a high to advanced skill level in keelboats or sailors who have previously participated in the SKP.

Sailors can refine their skills to an advanced level and may apply to compete at various events.

JUNIOR SQUAD (13-18 Years Old)

The SKP Junior Squad targets sailors aged 13 - 18 who are active dinghy or keelboat sailors and can demonstrate a high level of fleet racing skills.

The Junior Squad will train once a week and focus on developing an intermediate to a high standard of boat handling skills in the Squadron's fleet of Elliott 7s. Sailors will have the opportunity to compete in various local and state regattas (please refer to 'target regattas').

Junior Squad Training

Junior Squad sailors will participate in 19 training sessions from 3 May 2023 to 20 September 2023 on Wednesdays between 5:30 am - 8:00 am. There will be 10 training sessions from 11 October 2023 to 13 December 2023 on Wednesdays between 4:30 pm - 7:30 pm.

Please note that the start time is when the briefings will begin, and the end time is when we expect sailors will be able to leave. All training sessions are compulsory; sailors who cannot attend the training session must notify the SKP Coordinator and their coach.



In addition to the weekly training sessions, sailors are strongly encouraged to maintain their dinghy or keelboat sailing on the weekends.

Junior Squad Fees

The SKP Junior Squad fees include 29 training sessions, coaching fees for both training & regattas and entry fees to all target regattas. Uniforms will be provided. The SKP Squad fees do not include RSYS membership fees, the end-of-season presentation, transport to and from regattas, regatta accommodation (billeting will be provided where possible) or food at regattas. The Subsidised Fee is applicable all participants who are a current Youth Member and have a Parent/Grandparent/Guardian Member. The Unsubsidised Fee is only applicable to participants from the 2022 - 2023 season who are a Youth Member and do not have a Parent/Grandparent/Guardian Member.

SKP SENIOR SQUAD (18-22 Years Old)

The SKP Senior Squad targets sailors aged 18 - 22 years old, who can demonstrate a high level of sailing ability at a national level and/or have previously participated in the SKP.

The Senior Squad will train once a week and focus on refining their keelboat handling and match racing skills at an advanced level. Sailors will have the opportunity to be selected to compete at local, national, and international youth match racing events.

Senior Squad Training

Senior Squad sailors will participate in 20 training sessions from 1 May 2023 to 25 September 2023 on Mondays between 5:30 am - 9:00 am. There will be 17 training sessions from 9 October 2023 to 26 February 2024 on Mondays between 3:30 pm - 7:30 pm. As a trial, Senior Squad will have access to a squad fitness session on Wednesday afternoons from 6 - 7 pm. Senior Squad sailors also have three training camps. These camps are compulsory for the senior sailors and are scheduled around key regattas.



- Camp 1: 26-28 June 2023 (9 am 4 pm)
- Camp 2: 4-6 November 2023 (9 am 4 pm)
- Camp 3: 20-21 January 2024 (9 am 4 pm)

Please note that the start time is when the briefings will begin, and the end time is when we expect sailors will be able to leave. All training sessions and camps are compulsory; sailors who cannot attend the training session must notify the SKP Coordinator and their coach.

Senior Squad Fees

The SKP Senior Squad fees include 37 training sessions, 3 training camps, coaches fees for both training and regattas and entry fees to all target regattas. Uniforms will be provided. The SKP Squad fees do not include RSYS membership fees, end-of-season presentation tickets, transport to and from regattas, regatta accommodation (billeting will be provided where possible) or food at regattas (lunches are provided at some regattas). Participants must be a current Intermediate Member. Members may pay in monthly amounts through their member account.

- SKP Senior Squad Subsidised Fee: \$1,700.00

WINTER SKP OPEN SQUAD (22+ Years Old)

The SKP Open Squad targets sailors over 22 years old who can demonstrate a moderate to a high level of sailing ability in keelboats or have previously participated in the SKP.

The Open Squad will train once a fortnight and focus on refining their keelboat handling and match racing skills at an advanced level. Sailors will have the opportunity to compete in club racing and be selected to compete at national and international open-match racing events.

OPEN SQUAD TRAINING

The Open Squad sailors will participate in 8 sessions from 4 May to 14 September 2023. These training sessions are compulsory for all sailors and will be held on Thursdays between 5:30 am - 8 am.

OPEN SQUAD TRAINING CAMP

The Open Squad has one training camp scheduled for 5 - 6 August 2023 from 9 am - 4 pm. This training camp is compulsory for Open Squad sailors and has been scheduled around the major regattas.



OPEN SQUAD FEES

The SKP Open Squad fees include 8 training sessions, a training camp, entry fees to all target regattas and coaching fees for both training and regattas. Uniforms will be provided.

The SKP Squad fees do not include RSYS membership fees, end-of-season presentation tickets, transport to and from regattas, regatta accommodation (billeting will be provided where possible) or food at regattas (lunches are provided at some regattas). Participants must be a current RSYS Member.

SKP Senior Squad Subsidised Fee: \$700.00

APPENDIX A - ADDITIONAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

UNIFORM

SKP participants will be provided with uniforms that must be worn at training and events. In addition to the provided uniform, sailors are expected to bring their own clothing and equipment in line with the uniform guide.

VOLUNTEERING

All members of SKP squads are expected to contribute to the Squadron through volunteering. Volunteering includes, but is not limited to, assisting the club in race management, race support, and boat maintenance. Opportunities to volunteer will be posted on the SKP calendar and volunteer expression of interest form. It is the responsibility of the sailors to organise their volunteer hours.

Completed volunteer hours will be taken into consideration during team selection.

REGATTA SELECTION

Selection for regatta teams will be at the discretion of the SKP management team. A position in the SKP program alone does not guarantee selection for regatta.

Sailors in the SKP program can submit individual or team expression of interest for an event. If sailors are unable to form a team, the SKP management team will select squad members who submit individual expressions of interest.

Selection Process

- 1. Sailors fill out an EOI form for the event that they intend to attend.
- 2. Six weeks before an event, the EOI will close for all sailors.
- 3. SKP management team will select and propose the sailors that will compete to the Sailing Committee for approval.
- 4. Four weeks before an event, the selected team will be announced via email.

Selection Criteria

Sailors' selection will be based on several factors and will include the following criteria:

- Attendance at training sessions is above 80% (minus approved leave)
- Demonstration of excellent sporting behaviour, strong work ethic, teamwork, enthusiasm, integrity and leadership
- Recent performance at training and events
- Number of volunteer hours completed
- Number of events previously attended
- Agree to complete a regatta report, including any relevant media


The following variables are also considered in team selection: strength, age, gender, weight, positions available, team dynamics and skipper ranking.

NB: the SKP management team reserves the right to amend the selection process and criteria at their discretion. Sailors will be notified about any major changes.

END-OF-SEASON PRESENTATION

A casual presentation dinner for all SKP sailors will be held at the Club on 1ST March 2024. Tickets for this event will be \$30 per person and are not included in the SKP squad fees. Sailors are allowed to invite their parents or partners if they wish.
