Judge Milford's second son Herman was a barrister who worked chiefly at the equity bar. Herman died in November, 1865 at the age of 37. His brother Dr. Frederick Milford was an enthusiastic yachtsman of whom it was said in later years, "no more ardent lover of the sport ever held a tiller".
