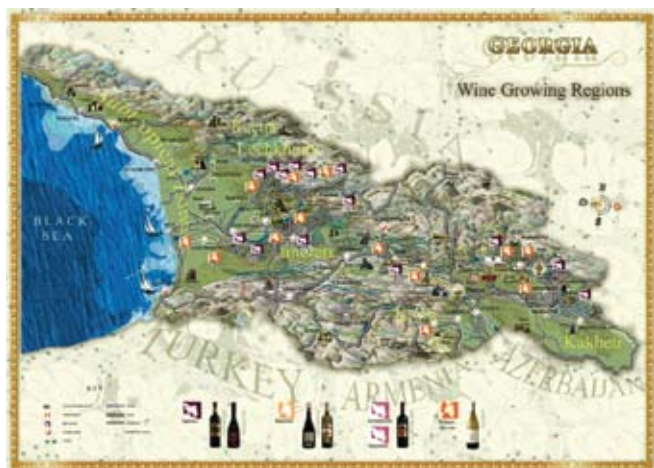

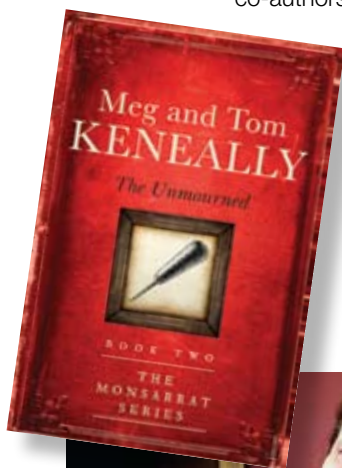


Literary Luncheon
