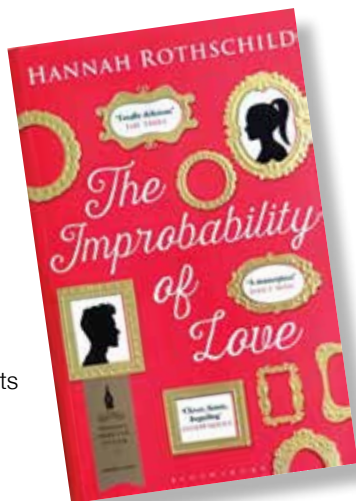

This selection is from the **Big Books area on the bottom book shelves**, on both sides of the fireplace, in the Kurraba Reading Room.

The World's Best Sailboats. Ferenc Maté. A survey and evaluation of the best sailboats being built in the 1980's: Aldens, Baltics, Hinckleys, Swans, Shannons, plus 14 others. Contains 400 colour photographs. 1989. *Spine Label Maté*.

The Love of Sailing. Douglas Phillips-Birt. Includes early sailing boats, tall ships, sail training dinghies, popular cruising yachts, America's Cup entrants, multi-hulls, and lone sailors and their boats. Contains 120 colour plates. 1975. *Spine label Phil*.

Sparkling Sydney. Bruce Stannard and Leo Meier. Our magnificent harbour provides one of the most spectacular sites in the world for a city. The evocative photographs, especially commissioned for this book, by Leo Meier, and the text by Bruce Stannard, reveals an intimate knowledge of the city, the landscape and the people of Sydney. 1989. *Spine Label Stan*.

Great Yachts and Their Designers. Jonathan Eastland. Recounts the evolution following the changing forms of yachts from 1890 to the 1980's – telling the story of designers, the boats they created, and the great races that made them

famous. Includes the most famous yachts *Britannia* and *Stars & Stripes* – and yachts that, although not famous, stand as milestones in the history of yacht design. 1987. *Spine Label East*.

The Eighties Greatest Yacht Races. Introduction by Sir James Hardy. Includes text and photographs of the Sydney – Hobart, the America's Cup, the Whitbread Round-the-World race, the BOC Single-Handed Round-the-World race, and the Flying Eighteens. 1988. *Spine Label Eigh*.

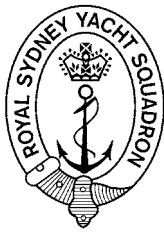
