NOTICE OF PROGRAM

INTRODUCTION

The Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron (RSYS), as the Organising Authority (OA), invites eligible **RSYS Members** to participate in the RSYS Dinghy Training Squads Program, for Winter 2019.

1.0 RULES

1.1 General Rules

The Dinghy Training Squads Program will be governed by the current versions of;

- the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS), of World Sailing (WS),
- the Rules (RRS) Prescriptions of Australian Sailing Ltd. (AS),
- the Special Regulations (Part 2 - for off the beach boats) 2017-2020, of Australian Sailing Ltd.,
- the Class Rules of any One Design Class or Class Association, where applicable,
- the RSYS Conditions of Entry,

1.2 Changes to the Notice of Program

The Organising Authority reserves the right to amend the Notice of Program. Amendments will be published on the RSYS website and may also be emailed to all participants.

1.3 Youth Sailing Committee

The RSYS Youth Sailing Committee will be on site on Sundays to help parents and sailors to participate in the Dinghy Training Squads Program. This will be in a volunteer capacity and the RSYS Sailing office are the deemed (OA)

1.4 Program Duration

The duration of the Dinghy Training Squads Program for Winter 2019 will be;

- commencing the week beginning Monday April 29th, 2019,
- concluding the week beginning Friday September 27th, 2019.

3.0 CLASSES & SQUADS

3.1 The RSYS Youth Training Squads Program is open to participants with boats of the following invited Classes;

3.2 The Organising Authority, at its discretion, may add, alter, amalgamate or divide any Class as required.

3.3 The Organising Authority may cancel any Class or Squad if a minimum of five (5) registrations have not been received.

4.0 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 4.1 The RSYD Dinghy Training Squads Program is open to all that meet the specific participant and boat eligibility requirements. The OA may, at its discretion, vary these eligibility requirements if it deems that the entry of a participant or boat in the program has the potential to advance the quality of training within the program.
- 4.2 Participant Requirements
 - a participant shall be a 'financial member' of the Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron,
- 4.3 Boat Requirements
 - a boat shall comply with the current Class Rules of her Class Association,
 - a boat shall comply with the current Special Regulations (Part 2) of Australian Sailing Ltd.,
 - a boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance, with a minimum cover of not less than AUD \$5,000,000 (recommended AUD \$10,000,000).

5.0 REGISTRATION AND FEES

- 5.1 The procedure for registration shall be as outlined in Appendix 'A' of the Notice of Program.
- 5.2 The Program Fees for Dinghy Training Squads Winter 2019, shall be as outline below;

- 5.3 Program Fees are inclusive of all Training Sessions. Where available, pre- regatta training camps for RSYD Supported events are also inclusive. Additional costs associated with boat storage, specialist coaching and away regatta entry fees may be incurred.
- 5.4 There is an away championship for the Optimist and the Pacers, this will incur an addition cost of \$44 per boat. Please see Appendix 'G' for more details

6.0 SCHEDULES

- 6.1 The schedule of Training, Racing and Events shall be as outlined in Appendix 'B', Appendix 'C', Appendix 'D' and Appendix 'G' of the Notice of Program.

7.0 WINTER RACING SERIES

- 7.1 A separate Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions will be published for the RSYD Winter Racing Series.
- 7.2 The Winter Racing Series will be scheduled throughout the program period, occurring at the Club approximately once a month.

8.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 8.1 Participants shall participate in the Squads entirely at their own risk. The Organising Authority and their respective officer's, employees, volunteers and members, will not accept any liability for any loss, material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the race.
- 8.2 The Organising Authority is not responsible for the seaworthiness of a competitor's boat whose entry is accepted or the sufficiency or adequacy of its equipment.

- 8.3 Competitors attention is drawn to RRS 4.0 'Decision to Race'.
"The responsibility for a boats' decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

9.0 INSURANCE

- 9.1 A boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance, with a minimum cover of not less than AUD \$5,000,000 (recommended AUD \$10,000,000).

10.0 MEDIA RIGHTS AND RESTRICTIONS

- 10.1 Each competitor participating in the series consents to the Organising Authority distributing information to the competitor regarding, racing, marketing and associated event information including social events. This information may be distributed by email, web, mail, fax, mobile phone messaging and telephone.
- 10.2 Conditions of entry include a requirement that the Person in Charge of the boat and crew;
- Acknowledge that the Organising Authority owns all media rights to the series and may exercise those rights as it sees fit,
 - Grant the Organising Authority and Event Partners the unconditional, perpetual right and authority to publish and broadcast anywhere in the world, for any purpose and in any media, the names, images and biographical information relating to the crew and photographs, video footage and audio recordings taken of the boat and its crew prior to, during and after the race.

APPENDIX 'F' – TUESDAY MORNING REQUIREMENTS

F1.0 Lights and Visibility

F1.1 All boats participating in the Tuesday morning training must abide by NSW RMS law. This include navigation lights for boats underway. Any boat not compliant to NSW RMS will not be able to launch or participate until after 7am.

F.1.2 Please see below the requirements for boats wanting to participate in the Tuesday Trainings Vessels under 7 meters
Shall exhibit one of the following:

- Separate or combined sidelights; a masthead light or
- Separate or combined sidelights and an all-round white light.
- The masthead or white all-round light shall be carried at least one meter above the sidelights.
