



RSYS CAR PARK POLICY GUIDELINES

The car park may only be used by General Members, Visiting Members and Honorary Members. Temporary Members may only use the car park from time to time when authorized by the CEO/Club Secretary.

The car park is only available for use by Members whilst they are present at the Squadron or whilst they are using their vessel listed on the Squadron Register or whilst they are participating in a Squadron or related aquatic activity.

Cars are not permitted to be left in the car park overnight unless the Member or Guest of Member is staying on the Squadron premises, is away overnight on aquatic activities or due to ill health of the driver.

Trailers must not be left in any car park. A request to leave a trailer in the car park must be made in writing to the Secretary prior to the trailer being left at the Squadron.

Unauthorized trailers will be towed off the premises and left on the street. The Squadron accepts no liability for trailers stolen or damaged when moved in this manner.

No flammable, corrosive or dangerous goods are to be left in the car park. All vehicles or equipment left in the car park is done so at the Members own risk. The Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron does not accept any liability or loss or damage to property in the car park or resulting from the use of the car park.

Members are not able to book car parking spaces.

Members must leave the car park in a quiet manner that respects our neighbours.

Car park use is restricted to RSYS members only during the following times;

Friday 3.00pm-6.00pm

Saturday Before 6.00pm

Sunday All day
